

Rara Lake Camping Trek

One of the most beautiful part of the Nepal situated about 350 km. North-west of Kathandu, Rara lake is a good destination point for trekking in the western part of Nepal. The country's largest lake, Rara can found one of the finest parks of the world in Rara National Park. It is Nepal's smallest and scenic national park which covers 106 square km. an altitude of about 3000 meters, which had established in 1976. Trekking in Rara offers the best scenery views of the Rara Lake, the thickly forested hillsides and the snow-capped peaks around it. The trek to Rara lake begins at Jumla, a village in a

Trans-Himalaya area, the rides covered with forests and alpine pasures. The flight to jumla passes south along the Dhaulagiri range and provides lovely view of Nepal's western landscape.

It is three and a half day's trek from jumla to Rara National Park. Along mountain paths and a series of picturesque villages, one reaches the magnificent banks of Rara lake. The peaceful surrounding is enhanced by the reflection by the surrounding hills in the Lake's bright blue waters. Rara come within the catchment area of the Karnali River, one of the three main river systems of Nepal. The habitat supports animals like red panda, black bear, yellow-throated martin, ghoral, serow and musk deer. There have also been reported sightings of leopard and wolf. The lake attracts migrant wildfowl like teal, pochards and mallards. Resident birds include the Impeyan, Kalij and blood pheasant as well as others like the chukkor partridge. Rara area is covered with coniferous forest, Rhododendron, black juniper, west himalayan spruce, oak and himalayan cypress. One of the best ways to overlook the flora and fauna is by walking through fine grassland and typical villages where you can find unique religions and cultures, as well as abundant wild life. In fact, Rara trek offers you the opportunity to have an adventure which you will never forget.
